## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

To report an emergency, call 702-892-7400, then notify Cinnamon and Kurt immediately.

- <u>Do Not Call 911.</u> Dialing 911 will delay the response by medical personnel who may not be able to find or get to the location of the emergency.
- To report via text message: Text LVCC and your message to 78247.
- Customer safety staff is trained to handle emergency situations. The Customer Safety Department is operational 24 hours a day and becomes the communications center and command post in the event of an emergency.
- First aid is located in the main lobby near the elevators (near Registration)

## **Dress Code**

**Move-In:** AIMExpo move-in shirts, jeans, closed toe shoes

**Show days:** AIMExpo show shirts, black pants/blue jeans (must be nice, not faded, no holes), professional closed toe shoes

- It will be cool in Vegas (it can drop to 40 degrees at night); if you choose to wear a shirt under your AIMExpo show shirt, it should be white or black.
- Non-branded, professional sweatshirt/hoodie/jackets may be worn during move-in if needed.
- Move-in and Show shirts will be provided on showsite at the MIC Business Center (location subject to change). Please plan to return your shirts at the end of the show.

## **Radio Etiquette**

Show radios are used for short, efficient communications throughout the show. Radios should be signed in and out each day at the MIC Business Center.

- Radios must be signed in and out from the business center each day
- Do listen before pressing the button to speak to ensure you aren't "walking" over an existing conversation
- Do hold the button for a second before speaking; there is a lag between pressing and transmitting
- Do ALWAYS be professional; exhibitors, attendees, staff, and VIP's can hear the radio
- Do **NOT** broadcast an emergency
- If you need something provided by the building, Shepard, the show contractor, AV, Catering, etc, please direct all requests through Kurt or Cinnamon
- If you turn your radio volume down, please remember to turn it back up ③
